Premier Events 2025 Explanation of Levels of Play

OVERVIEW

Our events draw teams from different parts of Canada and the USA. Different areas have different definitions for levels of play and have different game formats. This can create confusion for teams looking to register. As a result, we have tried to provide an information sheet to assist clubs with their placement at the time of registration.

TIERS

We are simplifying our registration by using tiers 1, 2, 3 and 4. These will take on slightly different meanings depending on the age. Please review your age group carefully to register and place your team correctly.

U9 - U10 (Spring Cup and International Cup only)

These age groups are considered SMALL SIDED and play 7v7 on a mini field.

These age groups associate to the following birth years.

- U9 2017
- U10 2016

We will have ONE tier of Development is these age groups.

U11 - to U13

The age groups are considered SMALL SIDED and play on a small sided field.

These age groups are associated with the following birth years:

- U11 2015 (play 8v8)
- U12 2014 (play 8v8)
- U13 2013 (play 9v9)

FOR SPRING CUP & INTERNATIONAL CUP

We will offer THREE tiers of play in these age groups as follows:

TIER 1 - top level development teams

TIER 2 - mid-range development teams

TIER 3 - lower range development or top level recreational/house teams)

FOR CANADA DAY

We will offer TWO tiers of play.

DEVELOPMENT - all mid to high level development teams

RECREATIONAL - all lower level development and recreational/house teams

For U13 teams who play in areas where they are playing 11v11. You may register as U14 but please email tmcculloch@premiersoccerseries.com when you register.

U14 - U19

These age groups all play 11 v 11 and associate to the following birth years.

- U14 2012
- U15 2011
- U16 2010
- U17 2009
- U18 2008

U19 (2007) teams register in U18.

TIER 3 - 3rd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Div 1 for 2008 & older teams and Div 2 for 2009 & younger teams - B Cup)

We will offer FOUR tiers of play.

TIER 1 - Premier/Top level of play in your area (in BC this would be BCSPL)

TIER 2 - 2nd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Metro for 2008 & older teams and Div 1 for 2009 & younger teams - A Cup)

TIER 3 - 3rd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Div 1 for 2008 & older teams and Div 2 for 2009 & younger teams - B Cup)

RECREATIONAL - recreational/house teams

FOR INTERNATIONAL CUP

We will offer three levels of play.

TIER 1 (for 2012 only) - Premier/Top level of play in your area (in BC this would be BCSPL)

TIER 2 - 2nd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Metro for 2008 & older teams and Div 1 for 2009 & younger teams - A Cup)

TIER 3 - 3rd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Div 1 for 2008 & older teams and Div 2 for 2009 & younger teams - B Cup)

TIER 4 - 4th level of play (In Vancouver this would be Div 2 for 2008 & older teams and Div 3 for 2009 & younger teams)

FOR THANKSGIVING CUP

We will offer Three levels of play.

TIER 2 - 2nd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Metro for 2008 & older teams and Div 1 for 2009 & younger teams - A Cup)

TIER 3 - 3rd level of play (In Vancouver this would be Div 1 for 2008 & older teams and Div 2 for 2009 & younger teams - B Cup)

RECREATIONAL - recreational/house teams
